Alan Pitt, MD, is a graduate of Stanford University (BA, '83) and the University of Arizona School of Medicine (MD, '88). As part of the Medical Student Research Program (MSRP) at the University of Arizona, he served in a research fellowship at the Karolinska Institute. Dr. Pitt's post-graduate training included Neurology and Radiology at the University of Texas at Southwestern, and a fellowship in Neuroradiology at the Barrow Neurological Institute. Along with his clinical responsibilities, Dr. Pitt is focused on technologies facilitating interoperability (defining and implementing standards for patients' shared digital medical records), and enabling patients to participate in their own care. He has collaborative relationships with Cisco, Microsoft, Philips HealthCare, and is an advisor to DICOMGrid and EmergeMD. He is also an adjunct professor at the Arizona State University Department of Biomedical Informatics.
