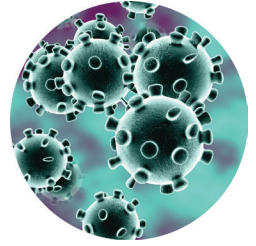


Coronavirus Classroom Assessment

This is a draft of a classroom survey for students grades 3-5. The questions are meant to be delivered on paper for students to answer individually, or verbally if the students have difficulty reading. There are four parts to this survey: *Demographics*, *Knowledge about the Coronavirus*, *Perceived Susceptibility*, and *Self-report of preventative behavior adherence*.
