

MPH in Public Health Practice Program Level Competencies

- Apply accepted financial concepts to analyze the fiscal status of public health, health care and non-profit organizations.
- Identify appropriate strategies to promote positive health behavior changes in various populations; and analyze and discourse on public health issues.
- Analyze and evaluate administrative, management and regulatory issues that impact the delivery of medical care in the U.S.
- Compare the strengths and weaknesses of organizational structures within local governmental, non-profit and community entities.
- Design a population-based program and intervention.
- Select methods to evaluate public health programs, and identify stakeholders for influencing public health outcomes.
