## **Chicanos Por La Causa (CPLC) Student Scholarship Announcement**

The Chicanos Por La Causa Inc. (CPLC) is pleased to announce a scholarship program for students at the University of Arizona Mel and Enid Zuckerman College of Public Health.

For the next two years CPLC will partner with the College of Public Health for 2 undergraduate students to receive full tuitions scholarship. It is the hope that by providing scholarships to individuals demonstrating an interest and commitment to serving our Hispanic populations, and whose professional goals include continuing service to those populations, we can assure that public health will be emphasized to all Arizonans in a culturally competent manner. This scholarship program will serve to develop a collaborative public health network to serve our State and local communities.

**Awards:** 2 full tuition scholarships will be made in the 2013 inaugural year for students in their *junior* year pursuing an undergraduate degree in the College of Zuckerman Public Health.

**Award Criteria:** Funds will be awarded to the undergraduate student in their *junior* year pursuing a degree in the College of Zuckerman Public Health. Candidates need to demonstrate a commitment to service in the Hispanic communities of Arizona and social awareness of Hispanic culture; talents and interests both inside and outside the field of public health. Preference will be given to applicants who have demonstrated leadership in and service to the Hispanic community.

**Selection Process:** Please submit an application to Assistant Dean Chris Tisch, Zuckerman College of Public Health, P.O. Box 24-5033, Tucson, AZ 85724 by 5:00 pm., August 22nd, 2013. Applications should not exceed 2 pages and should include name and contact information.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND CHECKLIST**

1. Application can be neatly hand written or typed. Application form may be copied.
2. Provide a copy of the most recent ***unofficial*** grade transcript.
3. Submit a **TYPED** personal statement (maximum of 2 pages double-spaced). Please include the following information in your personal statement.
  - Brief family history
  - Community involvement, leadership extracurricular and/or volunteer activities
  - Academic achievements and honors scholarships received. (Include dates and amounts awarded)
  - Educational goals & career plans in the field of Public Health
  - Description of how the scholarship award will be utilized to fulfill your educational goals.
